

## **BRUFA EDUCATION & TRAINING REPORT**

**BRUFA has no vocational training Programme at the moment. The current program is to provide our members with:**

- 1. Information, rules and regulations issued by various Government and other regulators which are relevant for the day-to-day operations**
- 2. And various short term courses or workshops, applicable to the trade, given by private or Government-departments sponsored trainers.**

**Currently the Brunei Government departments is embarking on e-Government. All departments are now gearing up to the IT system for most of their documentation and dealings with the public.**

**Due to this program there is regular short courses and seminars conducted by these departments, including the Royal Customs, The Ports Department and the the Ministry of Foreign Affairs & Trade, etc., where our BRUFA members are able to attend.**

**Some of these courses attended by our members are:**

- 1. A course on “Container Terminal Operations” given by the Ports Department in association with the United Nations Conference on Trade & Development (UNCTAD).**
- 2. There was another UNCTAD course on “Sea Ports Operations” which was attended by our members and they received certifications.**
- 3. The Customs and the Ports departments conducted a join workshop on e-declaration and e-manifest integration.**
- 4. The Customs Department organised a seminar on the e-Customs Duties & Taxes payment with the collaboration of three leading banks in Brunei.**
- 5. There is regular dialogue with the Ministries on the BIMP-EAGA Transport , Infrastructure, Information Communication Technology Development (TIICTD). In relation to this, there is regular programmes and information sharing which benefits our members.**
- 6. The Ministry of Communications is arranging a program on “Transport Logistics Competency” which our members will take part.**

**Some of our member companies also conduct their own in-house programmes as well as send their staff for IATA Courses.**
