Bangladesh Training & Education Report of the Year 2018-2019

BAFFA is committed to develop human resources of its member companies by extending Training and Educational Programs in a regular manner by using the establishment and facilities of Bangladesh Airlines Training Centre (BATC), managed by the Biman Bangladesh Airlines Ltd. which is associated with IATA Training Centre.

Apart from that, Freight Forwarders in Bangladesh are entitled to submit the IGM and EGM from their own position through the ASYCUDA World e-Manifest Program adopted by the Customs. To facilitate the member's number of Training Programs on ASYCUDA World was arranged with the active support of the National Board of Revenue (NBR).

BAFFA has taken initiatives to improve its various training & educational facilities towards its member companies with the active support of FIATA/IATA and Biman Bangladesh Airline. With support of FIATA & UNESCAP, BAFFA is planning to introduce FIATA Diploma & FIATA higher Diploma Courses in Bangladesh.

It is the intention of the association to hold training for freight forwarders, liability insurance problems on a regular basis to give opportunity to the members to train their staff periodically. BAFFA also has decided to open an authorized training school in Bangladesh in cooperation of IATA. This has been agreed in IATA Cargo Advisory Panel (ICAP) meeting for setting up the ATS in Bangladesh.

BAFFA'S AIM TO OFFER THE FOLLOWING COURSES:

Basic Cargo Dangerous Goods Course

This course covers IATA regulations governing the shipment of dangerous goods and the accomplishments of shipping documents related to the acceptance and handling of dangerous goods.

Basic Air Cargo Course

This course aims to provide participants with the basic concepts of air cargo forwarding operations and the skills essential for effective performance.

Basic Cargo Dangerous Goods Course

This course covers IATA regulations governing the shipment of dangerous goods and the accomplishments of shipping documents related to the acceptance and handling of dangerous goods.

Cargo Supervision

This course aims to provide supervisors with the basic concepts and skills in supervision which are applicable to an aircargo forwarding business setting.

Cargo/Logistic Management

This course aims to enhance the managerial competence of participants by exposing the participants to various management concepts and practices in the cargo industry.
