1. Education & Training;

E & T continued to be the main focus of FMFF to sustain a professional capacity development program. Training has now been extended to other members throughout the country as more employers understand and support the need for training & education for themselves and their staff.

For the period 2018-2019, FMFF organized and conducted several courses:

- UNESCAP - 516 participants
- FIATA Diploma - 77 participants
- Customs Agent Competency course – 592 participants
- Shipping Agent Competency course - 50 participants
- Incoterms 121 - participants
- English for Logistics - 66 participants
- Dangerous Good Regulations – 43 participants

2. Setting up MIFF (Malaysian Institute of Freight Forwarders)

At its recent Council meeting on 13/07/2019, FMFF had deliberated on the proposed constitution for MIFF and registration with the Registrar of Societies. The proposal was passed at the Biennial General Meeting.

MIFF would be promoted as a Centre of Excellence and would accredit relevant courses for the logistics industry, accredit logistics professionals and be the Industry lead Body for the Logistics industry. Currently, FMFF is recognized as the Industry lead Body by HRDF Human Resources Development Fund. At a recent meeting, Department of Skills Development have been requested to recognize and accredit MIFF as Centre of Excellence.

MIFF would have several categories of membership:

1. Honorary Fellow
2. Fellow
3. Ordinary members
4. Associate members
5. Student members
6. Institutional members.

All training & education programmes would be branded under MIFF and MIFF would be under the oversight of FMFF.
