1. Air Cargo Tonnage

In 2020, Malaysia Imported 374,680 metric tonnes against 315,497 metric tonnes in 2019, an increase of 59,193 metric tonnes or 16% compared to the preceding year.

Malaysia exported in 2020, 427,363 metric tonnes against 534,135 metric tonnes in 2019, decreased by 106,772 metric tonnes or 20%.

Total exports of 849,632 metric tonnes in 2019 against 802,043 metric tonnes in 2020. The tonnage dropped by 47,589 metric tonnes or 5.7%.

In 2021, Malaysia Imported 301,204 metric tonnes against 374,680 metric tonnes in 2020, decreased by 73,476 metric tonnes or 19.6%.

In 2021, Malaysia Exported 819,781 metric tonnes against 427,363 metric tonnes, an increase of 392,418 or 47.8%

Total of 802,043 metric tonnes for both Import & Export.

In 2022, Import was 361,941 metric tonnes against 301,204 metric tonnes in 2021, an increase of 60,737 or 16.80%. Malaysia Exported 513,785 metric tonnes, a decrease by 305,996 metric tonnes or 37%.

As at April 2023 the tonnage for Import was 115,189metric tonnes against 126,388 metric tonnes, decrease of 11,199 metric tonnes or 9%.

Malaysia's Export as at May 2023 was at 146,140 metric tonnes against 177,946 metric tonnes, decreased by 31,806 metric tonnes or 18%.

Total for the period was 261,329 metric tonnes against 304,334 metric tonnes in the corresponding period, decreased by 43,005metric tonnes or 14% compared to the preceding year.

2. PENANG CARGO TEMINAL EXPANSION.

The Penang International Airport is the third busiest airport in the country with a capacity of 6.5 million passengers per annum currently. Last year, it recorded 4.27 million passengers per annum even though the country's borders reopened in April. This showed that there is a trend of increasing numbers of passengers at the PIA so there is an urgent need for the expansion.

The last time the PIA was upgraded was back in 2009 and it was completed in 2013.

The expansion project will be able to increase the capacity of passenger arrivals from 6.5 million to 12 million passengers per annum.

3. AIRFREIGHT RATE

The rise in interest rates worldwide impacted business expansion plans and demand for consumer electronic products.

E&E components, comprising over 70% of the cargo exported and imported would continue playing an essential role in driving up the volume of freight handled in Malaysia.

Depending on the destinations, the current air freight rates from Malaysia to Asian, the United States and Europe has normalised.

There's now sufficient air cargo capacity; so the price has dropped.

Education & Training Report:

The President of FMFF has been appointed the Chairman of the Sectorial Training Committee for Freight Forwarding and Logistics industry, under the HRDC (Human Resource Development Corporation) The STC would focus on developing the framework for reskilling and upskilling of manpower in the logistics industry.
