## THE AIR CARGO AGENTS ASSOCIATION OF INDIA (ACAII)

### PROFILE:

The Air Cargo Agents Association of India (ACAII) is the only recognized national Association representing the IATA accredited air cargo Agents in India. The primary objectives of ACAII are to promote the growth of the air cargo industry in India, facilitate the ease of doing business, and safeguard the interests of its members. ACAII was found in 1970 with 16 members, and it currently has a strength of 550 members as per the details below:

Active Members: 280 (Head office/Registered offices of airfreight forwarders)

Associate Members: 235 (Branch offices of Active members)

Allied Airline Members: 13

Allied GSA Members: 13

Commercial Members: 09

✿ In order to meet the regulatory requirements and to develop job-related skills and expertise, ACAII encourages and arranges training programmes for the personnel of its members. ACAII conducts these training programmes in collaboration with Air India, Indian Aviation Academy and other authorized Institutions. The courses which are conducted for this purpose are:

1. Dangerous Goods Regulations (Initial)
2. Dangerous Goods Regulations (Recurrent)
3. Basic Cargo Introductory Course



In spite of the pandemic and the prevailing lockdown restrictions in many states in India, ACAAI was able to conduct a few training programmes successfully, adhering to the COVID protocols, in collaboration with Indian Aviation Academy/DGM Indian Academy of Logistics at New Delhi and with Air India/Blue Dart Aviation at Chennai . There were also various other trainings programmes conducted online for ACAAI members and their employees pan India.

Moreover, due to the COVID 19 crisis, it was not possible to conduct physical training programmes at various states in India, and hence ACAAI had requested the Indian Regulatory Body, Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), for extension in the validity of DGR Certificates that were expiring in this pandemic period. Currently, considering the lockdown and other restrictions pan India, DGCA has granted the extension in the validity of the DGR certificates till 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021.
