1. Office Name

Japan Air-cargo Forwarders Association (JAFA)

2. Brief History

JAFA is a non-profit corporation that represents the interests of air freight forwarders in Japan. It was founded on 1st Apr 1991 through a merger of, there-to-fore, three independent associations; namely, the International Air Freight Forwarders Association, the Domestic Air-cargo Consolidators Association and the International Air Express Association. On 1st June 1991, it was granted a license by Minister for Transport and Minister for Finance in accordance with relevant laws.




2020 Cargo Trend in Japan





■ The three pillars of our activitis

- 1. The first point is safety, and recently, the national government has been tasked with preventing illegal activities such as terrorism in the event of a national ceremony.
- 2. The second point is the further enhancement of the education and training business.
- 3. The third point is the promotion of efficient logistics that maximizes speed and high transportation quality.

■ Topics (Our activities from 2020 to 2021)

- From 2020 to 2021, the association's activities were restricted and many events have been cancelled or postponed due to the impact of COVID-19.
- · Many seminar, workshop and training, we were moving to online as much as possible.

① Implementation of various campaigns

- Prevention of smuggling of socially evil goods, etc. based on the Memorandum on The Prevention of Smuggling (MOU)
- 2. Cargo Insurance Promotion Campaign
- Prevention of loading dangerous goods without declaration of domestic air cargo. Raising awareness of shippers by displaying posters and distributing flyers at the cargo reception desk.

② Holding seminars

- 1. JAFA Seminar "New system introduced by the antimonopoly Act Amendment was held on December 1, 2020, with 121 peoples.
- 2. The workshop of domestic air cargo dangerous goods handling course was held in January 2021, with 200 peoples.
- 3. An exchange of views with the Ministry of Finance Customs office related to the Smart Customs Initiative 2020 was held.
