Air Cargo Agents Association of Pakistan (ACAAP), is the Sole Representative Body of IATA Air Cargo Agents/Freight Forwarders in Pakistan who are providing services to the Exporters & Importers all over Pakistan.

ACAAP is a Registered with the Ministry of Commerce, Government of Pakistan having License No.15. Being a National Association, ACAAP has its own identity; on administrative points of view and as per Governmental Trade Organizations Rules in Pakistan, ACAAP has two regions all over Pakistan, A & B.

The Head office of ACAAP is situated at Karachi while Regional office is at Sialkot and another office at Lahore.

Air Cargo Agents Association of Pakistan (ACAAP) was formed in the year 1984 and was registered with the Ministry of Commerce Government of Pakistan in 1993 and was re-registered in 2007 as per the rules of Trade Organizations Ordinance 2007.

ACAAP nominated representatives at FPCCI leads the federations Air Cargo Committee, Aviation Committee and other different Standing Committees as their National Conveners and interacts with all concerned governmental institutions with authority to resolve problems faced by Air Cargo community in the country. A team of dedicated senior IATA Air Cargo Agents looks after the affairs of the association and takes all steps which are necessary to initiate or promote actions which is likely to be beneficial to the Air Cargo Industry in the country and to oppose all actions which may be calculated as to adversely affect the interest of the industry in the country.
