HUMAN RESOURCE COMPETENCY

ILFA had also been appointed member in task force for preparation of National Qualification Framework (KKNI) for Logistic industry.

ILFA together with Depot Container Association (ASDEKI) and Truck Company Association (APTRINDO) had jointly create PT Logistik Insan Prima (LIP), the first logistic Occupational Certification Body (LSP) in Indonesia which endorsed by National Occupational Certification Body (BNSP) and Ministry of Human Resource.
