The Education and Training Committee (ETC) advises the BAFFA Board on strategic planning and development of industry-focused training and educational activities. The Board has approved, in principle, the establishment of a permanent Training Institute aimed at enhancing professional knowledge and operational capacity within the freight forwarding community of Bangladesh.

BAFFA is currently in communication with International Air Transport Association regarding the establishment of an IATA Affiliated Training Center (ATC) in Bangladesh.

Future Training & Education Initiatives:

BAFFA plans to further strengthen professional capacity-building in Bangladesh through:

- Establishment of an IATA Authorized Training School (ATS)
- Introduction of FIATA Diploma and FIATA Higher Diploma Programs
- Expansion of industry-oriented logistics and supply chain training
- Collaboration with universities and international development partners
- Development of digital and blended learning platforms for freight forwarding professionals

BAFFA remains committed to developing a professionally skilled, internationally competitive, and globally connected freight forwarding workforce in Bangladesh through continuous education, strategic partnerships, and industry-focused training initiatives.
