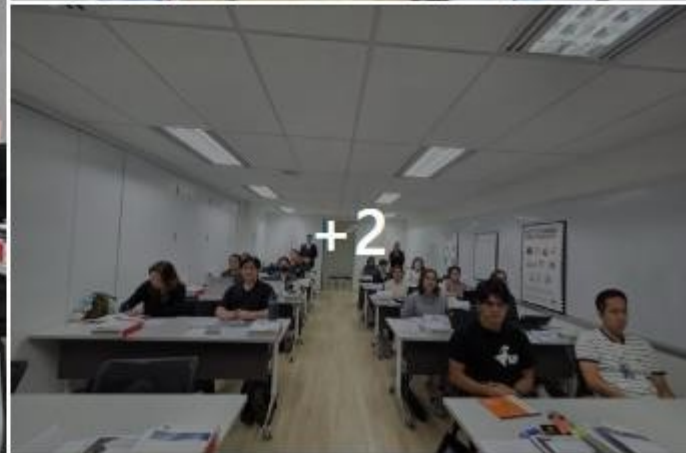

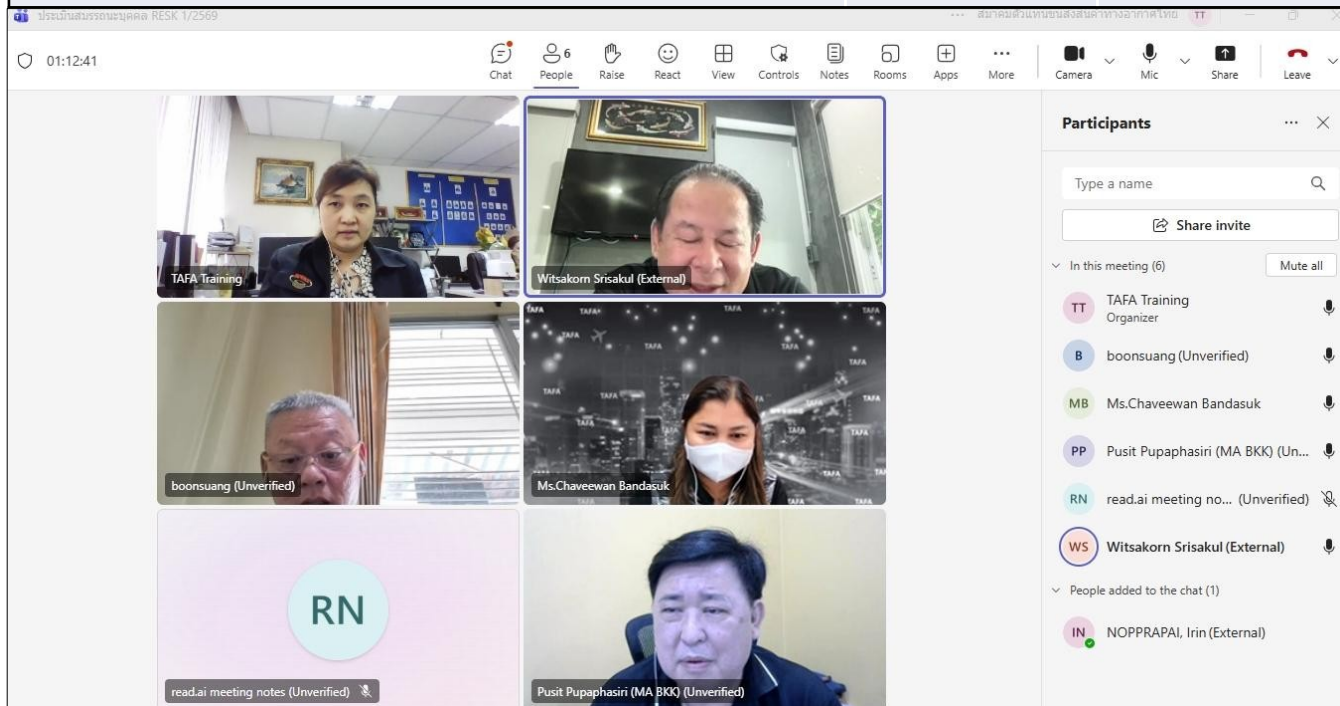
TPQI Certify Body (CB)
