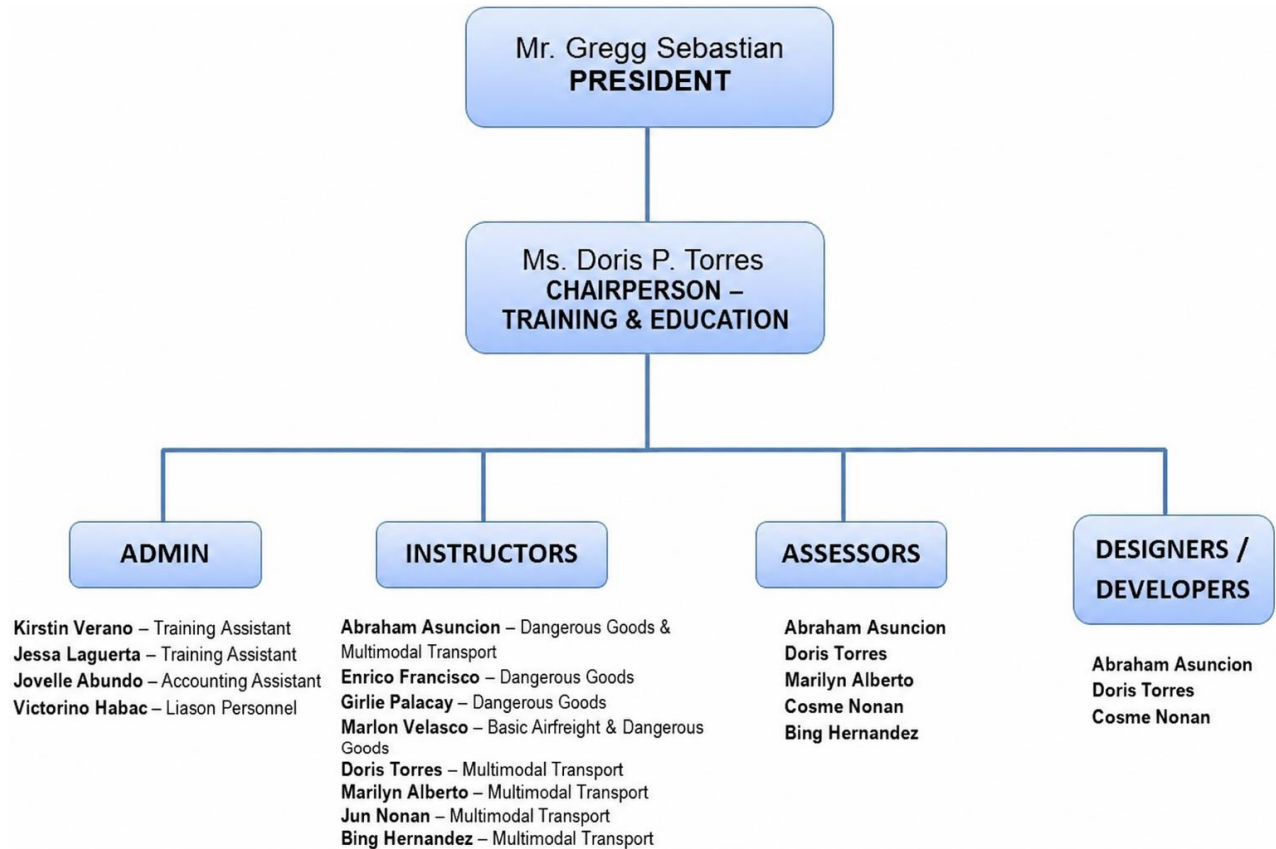

4. – Handling Cargo in a Warehouse for Handling, Loading and Unloading ULD and Loading & Unloading Aircraft Cargo Compartments
5. – Accepting Passenger and Crew Baggage, Managing Aircraft Boarding Areas
6. – Planning or Aircraft Loading
7. – Flight Crew
8. – Flight Operations officer and Flight Dispatchers
9. – Cabin Crew
